Usually, brackets and archwires are placed on the outer surfaces of the teeth (fig. 1). As they are visible when talking or smiling, patients often feel insecure.

Now there is an alternative – the so-called lingual technique. This allows the whole apparatus to be secured to the inner surfaces of the teeth which conceals it from the outside (fig. 2).

Invisible force

As lingual brackets are bonded onto the inner surfaces of the teeth, the apparatus is inside the mouth (fig. 3). The effect is virtually the same as when using the normal bracket technique, the only difference being that the force is applied from the opposite side.

Due to their very flat design, 2D[®] lingual brackets differ from conventional lingual brackets. They are barely noticeable to the patient and provide the best invisible patient comfort. All that remain visible are the successful results of the treatment!
